

POLICY DOCUMENT ON GREEN AND PLASTIC FREE CAMPUS

The important policy objectives are

- 1. Annual Green Audit and Energy Audit is to be carried out from time to time.
- To develop an efficient waste management system: Discard all kinds of waste material such as broken furniture, unusable equipment, etc on the campus
- 3. To tap rain water by constructing rainwater harvesting pits.
- To minimize air pollution in and around the college by using public transport or pollution-free means of transport such as bicycles.
- 5. Activate power management features on your computer and monitor so that it will go into a low power "sleep" mode when you are not working on it.
- Turn off your monitor when you leave your table, turn off unnecessary lights and use daylight instead.
- 7. Avoid the use of decorative lighting & Use LED or compact fluorescent bulbs.
- Keep lights off in conference rooms, classrooms, lecture halls when they are not in use & Use the
 fans only when they are needed.
- Time to time maintenance works of the electrical appliances like air conditioners etc., should be taken up for optimum usage of power.
- The college academic schedule should incorporate clean & green activity at least one hour per week.
- Programs that inculcate aesthetic sensitivity in student community like maintaining of green space on campus should be conducted through the Eco-Club committee of the college.
- 12. Plantation programmes in the campus in association with government local bodies.
- 13. Encourage the use of public transport and car-pooling for minimizing fuel consumption.
- 14. National and International Days of environmental significance like World soil Day etc., should be conducted to address the environmental issues including climate change.
- To create awareness in the local community about efficient energy usage, environment protection and sustainable development.
