# **FINAL REPORT**

## **Genesis – Telugu**

### **(A workshop on Creative Writing)**

A Work Shop on Creative writing was conducted on 01/12/21. Immediately, after completion of Meet the poet. Dr.sri Prasad Murthy , renewed Telugu poet and senior journalist in Telugu language, Dr. Rajeswari, writer and retired Telugu teacher(APRS), Ch.Srinivasa Rao, famous writer in Telugu( Rtd govt lecturer in economics), Smt. Simhadri Padma, Famous local Telugu poet ( Rtd Govt Telugu teacher) acted as resource persons.

Dr.Prasad Murthy explained how Intence Feelings and emotions transform into poetic thoughts. Giving examples form his own poems. He explained how writing for a specific task like TV or radio or different from free writing for the media we have to keep the time limit in view. Also into should draw the attention of the listeners in the first two or three sentences itself. He said that constant practice will help the writer to modulate according to the situation and ask the students to start practicing from that day itself.

Smt.Rajeswari explained how vast reading and regular practice help in framing the thoughts into beautiful poetic structures.

Dr.Ch Srinivasa Rao explained the techniques that make an essay or even a report written in prose get transcended in to poetic structures.

Smt.Padma explained how personal experience may be turned into two beautiful stories. She has given examples for varies types of stories explain the differences.

Students had given feedback on this workshop stating that the workshop was very useful and they would like to participate in more workshops of this kind. Some of them said that if on whole day was given to each resource person the workshop could have been more effective.
